Care Coordination provides in-home assessment and care planning to help connect seniors to the supports and services they need, including in-home and virtual help provided by volunteers.

RUOK are live check-in calls to ensure safety and wellbeing of isolated seniors. Information & Referral calls provide resources and support to seniors, their families, and the community.

Seniors A Go Go is a volunteer driver program to provide rides for seniors to medical and non medical appointments, as well the delivery of food and essential supplies.

## **NUTRITION SERVICES**

To help seniors access healthy, nutritious foods, we deliver food from our Food Pantry, as well as match seniors with volunteers to help take them grocery shopping.

We help seniors find and maintain safe, affordable housing through shared housing, housing consultations, and onsite residential services.

# **OUR IMPACT**

#### FOR 50 YEARS, ELDERHELP

has been as a beacon of hope for older adults. With our support, ElderHelp clients stay in their homes longer, stretching out their finances and retaining their independence and dignity.

When compared with national averages, ElderHelp clients are 12.5 times less likely to experience a fall and 8 times less likely to be hospitalized.

The average age of an ElderHelp client moving into long-term care is 10 years older than the average senior.

#### FACTS ABOUT BEING A SENIOR IN SAN DIEGO

By the year 2030, 1 in 4 San Diegans will be ago 60 or older. Average social security income is \$1,827/mo. The **income needed to meet daily needs is 2.1 times that**.

One fourth of San Diego's 60+ population **do not have** access to 3 meals a day.

3 out of 5 senior renters **spend 30% or more of their income on rent**. In San Diego, 1 in 3 seniors **lives alone**. 1 in 5 seniors **don't** have access to transportation.

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
