OTHER WAYS



Amplify your generosity through gifts from Donor Advised Funds, stocks, bonds, IRAs, mutual funds or unwanted vehicles.

Donations of stock are exempt from capital gains taxes that might be applied if your stock value has grown since you bought it. Let ElderHelp keep the proceeds that would have been paid in taxes.

You may also reduce taxes on IRA distributions through qualified charitable distributions (QCDs). For individuals over 70.5 years, QCDs allow you to donate up to \$108,000 per year directly from an IRA to charities like ElderHelp. Donations must go directly from your IRA to qualified charities and can satisfy your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD).

These larger investments help stabilize ElderHelp and allow for sustainable growth.

THE GIFT OF CONNECTION

In a world that often overlooks its elders, ElderHelp stands as proof that simple human connection remains one of the most powerful forces for healing and hope. Through thoughtful matches between volunteers and seniors, we are reducing isolation all while fostering independence and dignity.

Consider Thomas, who had a serious foot injury that turned his life upside down. Before the injury, he walked more than 3½ miles daily. Afterward, simple tasks like grocery shopping became nearly impossible. Unable to drive or lift heavy bags, and unable to work his job as a security officer, Thomas found himself isolated and struggling.

Then ElderHelp connected him with Lauren, a volunteer shopper. "She is a ray of sunshine in my life," Thomas shared. Through ElderHelp's Seniors A Go Go program, kind volunteer drivers now also take him to doctor appointments. "I feel very grateful," he said. "ElderHelp's assistance really makes life more livable for seniors like me."



The impact flows both ways. Volunteers consistently report that their time with ElderHelp has become one of the most meaningful parts of their lives. They gain perspective and find deep purpose in knowing they're making a tangible difference.

Through careful matches between volunteers and seniors, we're not just reducing isolation—we're fostering the independence and dignity every person deserves.
